Georgia International Horse Park

Serving as the 1996 Centennial Olympic Games venue, today you may catch an event such as an equestrian competition, festival, concert, or sports competition. A 1400 acres park with over 15 miles of horse trails, eight miles of mountain bike trails, RV camping, Arboretum garden, golfing, hotel lodging, 173 designated acres of wetlands with nature center, and geocaching.

Big Haynes Creek Nature Center

173 acres of the GIHP has been designated as a nature preserve devoted to the preservation and study of native plants and wildlife. Enjoy walking the trails, canoeing, and watching wildlife from the observation platform overlooking the wetlands. More than five miles of trails to accommodate hikers, mountain bikers and horse enthusiasts. Open year round to the public from sunrise to sunset.

Arboretum at the GIHP

Stroll through the arboretum ("garden of trees" in Latin) located on the GIHP grounds. Offering a 5-acre patch of woods with walking trails. Posts and plaques are dedicated to particular trees within the area to deceased loved ones and friends. There are approximately 37 species, including the rare swamp chestnut oak, within the arboretum.

FROM ATLANTA

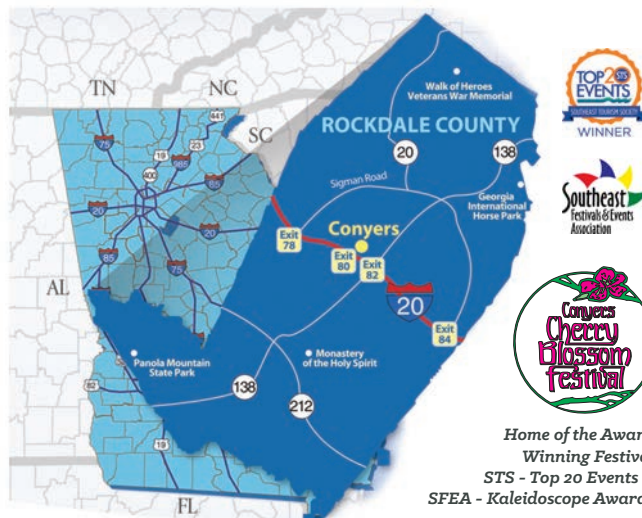
- Take I-20 East (towards Atlanta) to Exit #80, West Avenue

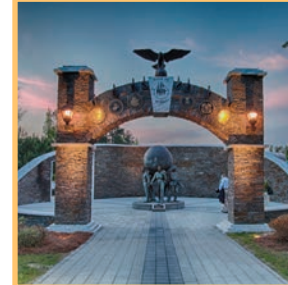

Haralson Mill Covered Bridge
 This bridge is the first of its kind to be built in Georgia since the 1890s. This bridge is 150 feet long and 36-feet wide. Its truss is styled with decorative lattice, and goes over Mill Rock Creek. There's a parking area, as well as a 1.75 mile scenic nature trail. Open to public.

Walk of Heroes Veterans War Memorial (Closed on Wed.)
 In a park setting, the memorial provides a self-paced and self-guided tour that is located on a 3-acre site adjacent to Black Shoals Park & Lake entrance. A botanical garden and public restrooms are also on-site.

Black Shoals Park & Randy Poynter Lake
