

There are approximately 37 species, including the rare swamp chestnut oak, within the arboretum.


- Take I-20 East (towards Atlanta) to Exit #80, West Avenue

Haralson Mill Covered Bridge

This bridge is the first of its kind to be built in Georgia since the 1890s. This bridge is 150 feet long and 36-feet wide. Its truss is styled with decorative lattice, and goes over Mill Rock Creek. There's a parking area, as well as a 1.75 mile scenic nature trail. Open to public.

War Memorial (Closed on Wed.) In a park setting, the memorial provides a self-paced and selfguided tour that is located on a 3-acre site adjacent to Black Shoals Park & Lake entrance. A botanical garden and public restrooms are also on-site.
